NOMINATION FORM

The Board of Church and Society of the Southwest Texas Conference has created this award to recognize active United Methodists who are outstanding educators of poor or at risk children with at least 10 years experience in primary or secondary public schools (including at least 5 years in the classroom) within the borders of the SWTX Conference.

The award will be presented at the Awards Banquet at Annual Conference of the current year. Recipient’s travel expenses to Annual Conference (up to \$200) to receive the award will be compensated and a gift of \$200 in honor of the recipient will be made to his/her public school employer.

Instructions: On a separate sheet of paper with the nominee’s name at the top, please

- Give examples of how your nominee’s work exemplifies the UMC Resolutions on Education noted above.
- Give examples of the impact that your nominee has had on students at risk.
- Explain what makes your nominee an outstanding role model.
- Describe nominee’s community and church involvement.
- List nominee’s educational background, teaching experience, and current educational setting.
- List educational or church awards received and awards to nominee’s students.

Signatures of Nominee, Nominator, and Nominee’s Pastor are required. Attach this cover page to your answers (no more than 2 pages). All completed applications must be received on or before **February 27, 2004** in order to be considered for the current year. Mail the completed nomination form to:
